Registration

This year registration will be all online using the MyNetball website and you will receive a link to register for all our existing members ONLY. (Please note that if you give this link to anyone that is not an existing Mudgeeraba player from the 2018 season, it takes away spots from our existing players. Registration for all Non-Existing members during the existing member sign on, will not be accepted by the club and they will be contacted and refunded.

New members to Mudgeeraba Netball club will need to email the club mudgeerabanetball@gmail.com and go on our club's waitlist. If you are currently on our waitlist, we will contact you from Monday 22nd January 2018 to advise if we have or do not have a spot in our netball club.

Registration is current when the club receives confirmation of completion of online registration and payment by the due date. Players are not covered by insurance until payment is received.

Players will not be eligible to participate in training, grading or fixtures until full registration is paid

Get Started Vouchers

Get started assists children and young people who can least afford or may otherwise benefit from joining a sport or recreation club. Mudgeeraba Netball Club Inc is an affiliated member of this program. Eligible children and young people can apply online for a voucher valued up to \$150, which can be presented at a Get Started sport or recreation club.

The next round for the program will open 24th January, 2018.

On the Mynetball registration this year there will be no discount as too many last year took up the discount and the club spent many hours and days chasing up outstanding vouchers or monies

IMPORTANT: This year our registration closes before the voucher is available and therefore if you are eligible to receive the voucher this year, please register as below instructions

1. Proceed with registration online
2. Chose the option to pay directly into the clubs bank account (account details will be advised)
3. Email the club the bank remittance along with advising us that you are intending to gain a voucher
4. By Sunday 28th January, 2018 the voucher needs to be emailed to the club mudgeerabanetball@gmail.com

If voucher is not received by Sunday 28th January, 2018 then you will be deemed un financial and will be able to participate in grading or training.

Club Photos

Mudgeeraba Netball Club will have professional to take team and individual photos taken on a nominated day throughout the season.

The cost of the team photo is not part of the fees this year and can be purchased through the professional photographer.

Club Duty Day

All Clubs affiliated with the HDNA are required to assist the Association to run the courts and games on competition days throughout the year. Each Club is usually allocated at least 2 days, where they are required to set up and pack up the courts, run the BBQ, crowd control and clean up rubbish.

Mudgeeraba Netball Club requires ALL families to assist on our allocated days. As we are a large club, we can share the workload around – therefore only a small amount of your time will be needed. Each team will be allocated a time (during or closely to either side of your game time), **please note that as we have many teams this year we will divide this up and each team will be only required to assist at one club duty day BBQ.**

Each team is usually allocated 30 to 60 minutes – this shared between 7 or 8 families is not a huge burden. The Executive often gets asked why parents are asked to help when their children's games are on – the answer to this is easy. Over the years we have tried various ways of sharing the workload – we know families are busy at the weekends and we have found that parents are less willing or able to come early or stay after their games to assist. We have found that parents are more available at the game time than either side of it. *If all parents make themselves available – then each should not miss much more than a quarter of their child's game.*

Whilst most families and our older players happily assist, unfortunately we have found this issue to be a cause of tension in previous years as some families simply refuse to assist.

Uniforms

All players must wear Mudgeeraba Netball Club Uniform of an A-Line Dress

HDNA requires that all players are to be in FULL Mudgeeraba Netball Club Uniform each week; this includes black sports pants and white socks. ***Wearing of bike shorts is permitted providing they are in only black and NOT visible below the hem line of the uniform***

Players who are not in full or correct uniform may be excluded from the game.

The uniform will be available in an A-line dress in girls and women's sizes.

In 2018 we are introducing club socks and a jumper/ hoodie, neither of these items are compulsory. The socks (crew and ankle available) will be available at the uniform sale days and the jumpers will be available for pre-order as soon as our samples arrive.

The club also have visors available for purchase, these are also not compulsory.

Want to sell your second hand uniform?

If you have the need to upsize in 2018 and would like to sell your current dress the club will attempt to do this via consignment only.

If you wish to see a uniform, we ask that you:

 - c. The price you wish to sell for
 - d. Your name and contact number
 - e. Bank account details
2. Dresses need to be given to the club by Thursday 31st January 2018, they can be dropped off to either our Uniform Convenor Nadeen Stammer 0423 953 293 (Robina area) or Tricia 0438 328 860 (Mudgearaba area). This needs to be done before the uniform sale day, so that the uniform conveyor has time to sort out stock and take inventory.

Please note, we will not be accepting any second-hand uniforms for sale on the actual sale day itself, as we will not have time to take inventory of second hand uniforms on the day.

Second Hand Uniforms will be available for purchase on the club uniform sale days.

Second Hand uniforms must be purchased with CASH only, please do not ask for these dresses are put on hold, there is a strict policy of immediate cash payment.

We have a large quantity of second hand dresses however not all sizes are not available.

The cost of the dress is determined by the seller, they generally range between \$20 and \$40 depending on the condition of the uniform.

March Past

Saturday 21st April 2018 is the official round 1 day of the season at HDNA and will take place at 8.30am (please be there at 8am). The march past involves each club marching together and all players are encouraged to make banners and streamers in club colours black, yellow and white and sing a chant. Training

Players in Under 7 years and up, will be required to commit to training sessions organised by the team coach, as this is very important to the success of the team. Training will be held at Hinterland District Netball Association courts on a school day afternoon.

Players please note:

Your training day and time will be determined by the availability of your coach. You will be advised of your training time when you are contacted by your coach.

IT IS COMMON COURTESY TO ADVISE YOUR COACH OR MANAGER IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND TRAINING OR A GAME IN ADVANCE SO THAT TRAINING PROGRAMS AND COURT ROTATION CAN BE ADAPTED.

Failure to comply, without reasonable excuse or phone call, may result in loss of court time during the Saturday game.

Good behaviour is essential at training to ensure all team members benefit equally and work to the best of their ability to develop new skills. Coaches volunteer their time and resources and deserve full support and respect by all club members. Their hard work and dedication should be appreciated.

Saturday Games

For the 2018 Netball Season, Hinterland District Netball Association game times as follows:

Net Set GO Under 5 – 6 years – 8.30am

Net Set GO Under 7 - 10 years - 8.30am and 9.30am games

Junior Under 11 - 18 years - 10.30am, 11.30am and 12.30pm games

Game times will not be decided until all team numbers are confirmed with HDNA and we do not take individual requests nor do HDNA for game times, it is based on court configuration with team numbers.

Net Set GO

Net Set GO is the only introductory program for netball. It has been developed to provide children from 5 - 10 years with the best possible introduction to the sport of netball. The program incorporates skill activities, minor games and modified matches in a fun and safe environment.

5 - 6 years (born 2013, 2012)

Children will follow the Net Set GO program for 7 weeks participating in drills and skills and **parent participation is required.**

First week commences Saturday 12th May and concludes on Saturday 23rd June.

7 years (born 2011) Non-Competitive Modified Rules

The Program will incorporate Drills and Skills session, 14 games and a Net Set GO Carnival.

Children play all positions on a rotational basis. This gives them experience, opportunity and skill development in all areas.

Net Set GO Modified rules apply however, No scoring is permitted. This is to encourage the children to focus on developing their skills - Not winning the game.

8 years (born 2010) Non-Competitive Modified / Full Rules

The Program will incorporate Drills and Skills session, 14 games and a Net Set GO Carnival.

Children play all positions on a rotational basis. This gives them experience, opportunity and skill development in all areas.

Full rules apply however, No scoring is permitted. This is to encourage the children to focus on developing their skills - Not winning the game.

9 - 10 years (born 2009, 2008) Non-Competitive Full Rules and will have junior umpires

Children play all positions on a rotational basis. This gives them experience, opportunity and skill development in all areas.

Full rules apply however, No scoring is permitted. This is to encourage the children to focus on developing their skills - Not winning the game.

Learner Umpires will be supplied by the club and an Umpiring Coach will be with the girls during the game.

JUNIOR / INTERMEDIATE (born 2007,2006,2005,2004,2003,2002,2001 & 2000) Competitive Full Rules

11 years up are to be graded before the season starts. The season will then proceed unchanged from previous years.

IMPORTANT COMPETITION RULES:

Junior competition, after the grading games, no player may play in a lower division than the one in which they are registered.

Junior Competition, after the grading games, a player registered in a division may NOT PLAY ACROSS in another team in the same division.

All players who take the court must sign the score card – including any “playing up” from another team. Where a player is playing up from another team, their division and team name must be included on the score card.

FORFEITS

If your team is expected to be unable to field the minimum 5 players for a game then you must notify the club first at least 24 hours before the game. The club will then contact HDNA on behalf of the team.

A forfeit fee by HDNA will be charged if your team has NOT notified the club by 10am Friday morning prior to the Saturday game.

Grading Information Sheet

Our Aim

Mudgeeraba Netball Club is committed to ensuring team grading is conducted fairly and effectively. The aim of grading procedure is to ensure grading of teams is undertaken in this manner and in the best interest of the club and players

The aim of grading is to form teams that have a balanced group of players of similar ability and levels across all playing positions. Grading will also be influenced by the number and ages of players registered with the club each year, eg; 16 registered players in a particular age group will form 2 teams of 8 players each, whereas 18 registered players would mean 2 teams of 9 players each.

Why Do We Grade Our Teams

Netball is a graded, competitive sport from the age of 11 with representative opportunities. To ensure the best chance of success for all teams and the greatest level of enjoyment and development of our players, it is necessary to grade players into teams with players of similar ability.

Stronger players always enjoy the challenge of a harder faster competition and do not develop to the potential if graded to a lower team to be kept with a friend.

Similarly, players who are placed in teams above their ability will also not develop to their potential when being constantly overshadowed by the more talented players around them. Players and parents should also be aware that success for a team one year does not always ensure they will remain together the following year. Due to the nature of change, new registrations and differing development rates of all players from season to season, player movement in and out of such teams may still occur.

Players and parents are urged to be objective and reasonable in their expectations and to encourage their children to be happy in their chosen sport no matter what team they are ultimately placed in.

The Grading Process

All grading is undertaken on behalf of the club by a Panel. The Grading Panel consists of suitable experienced graders appointed by the committee. From time to time the grading panel may also invite other independent graders to assist with the grading process. Where a conflict of interest exists (ie: the grading session involves the child of a grading panel member) that member of the panel shall stand down for the evaluation of that player.

Players turning 11 years up to intermediate will be graded to form teams of players with similar ability in order to compete against other teams of similar ability in the junior competition.

It is recognised that not all players may be available for both grading sessions but it is expected that players will make an effort to attend grading.

Two or three independent graders will be appointed to grade players on the day

Grading may include a number of activities including various netball training drills but will always include a session of actual on-court play.

Players presenting for grading shall be formed into teams for the purposes of this on-court game. Each grading session shall be watched by at least two (2) Graders and preferably three.

Players shall trial in two (2) positions that they have nominated. **However, this does not mean when placed in a team that they shall play only in these positions.**

Players may also be asked to trial in other positions, either to make up a team, or because the Graders would like to see how they perform in those positions. Where players are asked to fill other positions during grading, they will still have an opportunity to play in each of their nominated position/s during the selection process. For a number of reasons, it may not be necessary for all players to play an identical numbers of quarters during the game session.

Grading Criteria

Graders will judge players on skills, performance, teamwork and attitude.

In assessing the overall skills of a player within an age group, the Grading Committee will take into account:

- Footwork
- Speed and Agility
- Ball Handling Skills
- Attacking Skills
- Defending Skills
- Perception/Cognition Skills
- Sportsmanship and Attitude

The outcome of the grading session is that each player will be graded as being of either A, B, or C standard.

When forming teams the committee will also take into account any feedback provided by the previous year's coach and or manager in relation to behavior, teamwork, attitude and reliability.

Team Formation

Ideally nine (9) players will be selected per team however, due to numbers registered some teams may have eight (8) or a maximum of ten (10) players. **It is the aim to form teams with a balance of attack, mid court and defence players.**

A player may elect to play in a division lower than they are graded for individual reasons. Please speak to one of the selectors or to a committee member to have this noted.
